

Day services in Norwich Locality seem Healthy







Men's Sheds Association is Charity that offer support county wide. A lot of members are 65+

West Locality to be confirmed. Lucy explained that she is going to view a venue in February to make sure it is accessible






#### **Breakout Room Discussion (5)**
